- 1. Your entry form must be submitted on, or before, Saturday 1st September 2018.
- 2. Put this entry form into an envelope together with the total fee. (cash only). Seal the envelope and write "Show" on the front.
- 3. Put the envelope through the letterbox of a member of the Show Committee (for addresses, see bottom of this page). Alternatively, put the envelope into the Community Box at The Old School.
- 4. The entry fee is 30p per entry—or only 25p per entry if you are submitting 4 or more.
- 5. Entry fee for children is 10p.
- 6. Do not bring your actual Show entries (fruit, veg, flowers, photos etc.) to the Old School until the day of the Show. See 'Show Leaflet' for full details.

Show Rules

- 1. All entries, must be the sole work of the exhibitor, all of whom must be of amateur status. It is acceptable for a parent/carer to give limited assistance to a young child.
- 2. Produce must be grown in exhibitors own garden or allotment.
- 3. Notes on vegetable entries: carrots and parsnips should have foliage trimmed back to about 75mm; beans should be displayed with some stalk attached; tomatoes should be displayed with their calyx present (the green 'leaves' between the tomato and stem); cabbages should have about 50mm of stalk attached; leeks should have washed roots and their tops should be trimmed.
- 4. All cookery exhibits must be displayed on a white paper plate: or plain doilies may be used. (Plates and doilies will be available). Exhibitors of flowers are to provide their own vases or appropriate containers and be responsible for collecting them after the show.
- 5. Only stewards may move entries once they have been placed by competitors.
- 6. One name only on each entry-form. Use additional copies if necessary: photocopies are acceptable. Entry forms to be returned by Saturday 1st September 2018 to any committee member or via the 'Community Box' at The Old School, Cropwell Bishop.
- 7. Entry fee is 30p per entry but only 25p per entry if you are submitting 4 or more entries. Entry fee for children and students is 10p per entry.
- 8. All exhibits to be brought to The Old School between 8.00am and 9.30am on Sunday 9th September. Presentation of exhibits will be taken into account.
- 9. Judging will commence at 9.30am. The judge's decision is final. During the judging, only judges and the committee shall be allowed in the Old School.
- 10. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in any one class.
- 11. In all classes, points are awarded on the basis of 3 for 1st; 2 for 2nd and 1 for 3rd.
- 12. The 'Family Award' is awarded to the family with most points. In the case of a tie the winner with the most first prizes will be awarded the trophy.
- 13. To compete for the Family Award a minimum of 2 family members living at the same address must have submitted at least one entry each; one of the family members must be an adult and the other in Year 7 or below. An entry form is required from each family member entering and the box on the form for 'Family Entry' should be ticked.
- 14. Awards will be presented to the winners of: Grower (classes 1, 2, 3), Food & Drink (classes 4, 5, 8), Art & Craft (classes 6, 7), Best Child Entry (class 9) and Rock Cakes.
- 15. Certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded for every individual class. A trophy will also be presented to the winners of the 'Family Award'.
- 16. Any competitor wishing to lodge an objection must do so to the Show Committee before 3pm on the day of the show.
- 17. We would very much like to sell off exhibits in the Fruit, Vegetable, Flower and Cookery categories (classes 1 to 5) after we have presented certificates and prizes at 3.30pm: we believe that this will add to the enjoyment of the Show. Proceeds will contribute to the cost of the Show. However, you are of course welcome to hold back your entry from the auction: details on how to do this will be provided when you bring your entry to the Show.
- 18. No exhibit is to be removed from the Hall before 3.25pm. Exhibits that are not to be sold should be removed from the Hall by 4.00pm at the latest.
- 19. The committee shall have the power to deal with all matters not provided for in these rules. Whilst every reasonable precaution will be taken, the committee cannot be responsible for any loss or consequential damage. The Committee's decision is final.
